Eritrea and Djibouti Tensions: Could War Be A Result

The Recent Statements by the President of Djibouti regarding the State of Tensions with Neighboring Eritrea is just one more addition of chaos to a Region that is Very Unstable.

Any Conflict in the Region now has the Potential to Involve the US Military. This Fact cannot just be applied to Operations within Somalia either.
