አቶ ሙሉጌታ ገብሬ ከእናቱ ከወ/ሮ ዘለቀች ሣዳራ እና ከአባቱ አቶ ገብሬ ጫሶ እንደ አውሮፓውያን አቆጣጠር ታህሳስ 25 ቀን 1952 ዓ.ም. በአዲስ አበባ ከተማ ተወለደ። ወላጆቹ በንግድ ሥራ የሚተዳደሩ ስለነበሩ፤ የበኩር ልጃቸው የሆነውን ህጻን ሙሉጌታ ገብሬን ይዘው ወደ ሐረር ከተማ ሄዱ።

ሙሉጌታ ገብሬ ለትምህርት እንደደረሰ የአንደኛ ደረጃ ትምህርቱን ሐረር ከተማ በሚገኘው የመንፈሳዊ ትምህርት ቤት፤ መለስተኛ ሁለተኛ ደረጃ ትምህርቱን በልዑል ራስ መኮንን ትምህርት ቤት፤ የከፍተኛ ሁለተኛ ደረጃ ትምህርቱን በሐረር መድሃሐኒዓለም ትምህርት ቤት አጠናቀቀ።

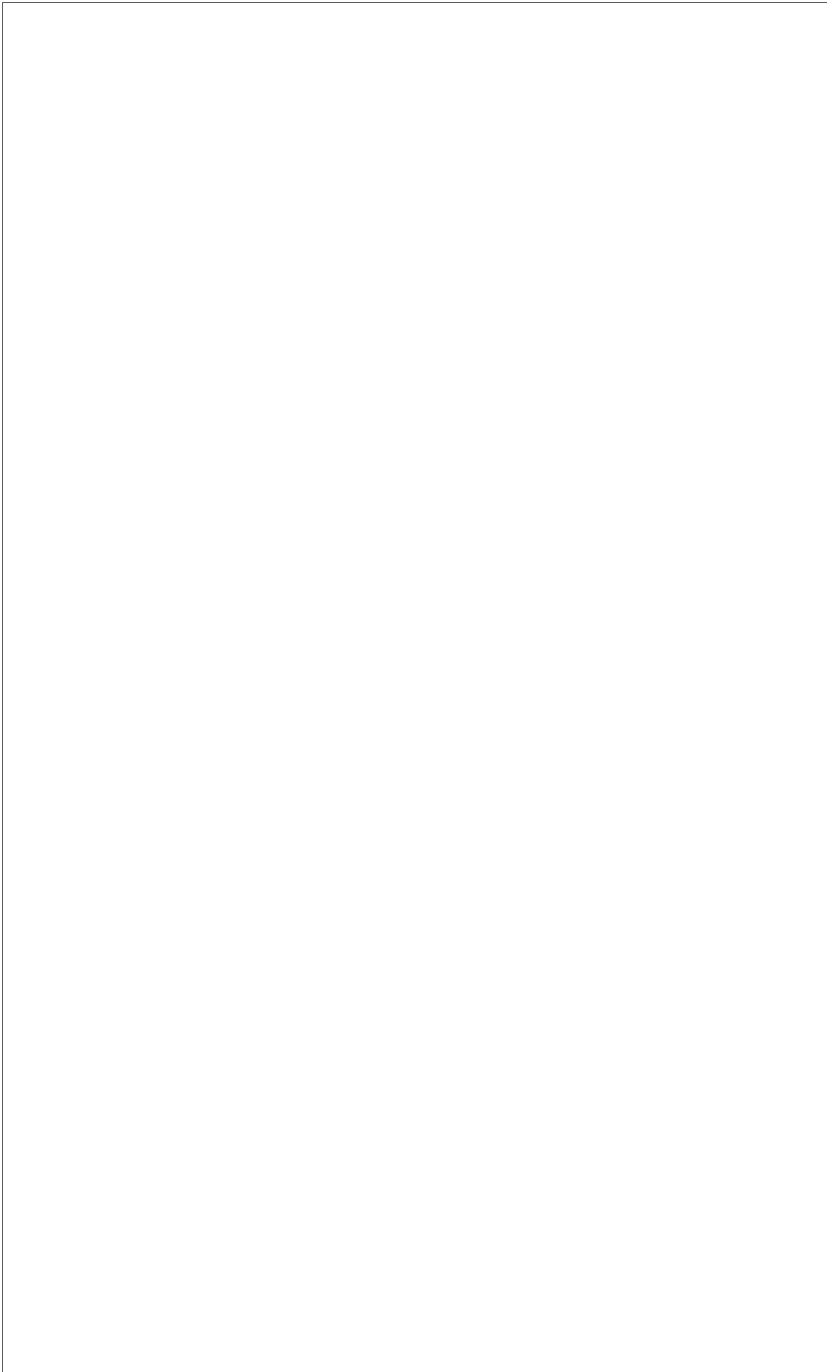
የሁለተኛ ደረጃ የመልቀቂያ ፈተናውን በጥሩ ውጤት ከአለፈ በኋላ አዲስ አበባ ዩኒቨርሲቲ (ጥንት ቀዳማዊ ኃይለሥላሴ የሚባለው) በመግባት ትምህርቱን በመከታተል ላይ እንዳለ፤ በአውሮፓውያን አቆጣጠር በ1970 በተነሳው የተማሪዎች ንቅናቄ ዩኒቨርሲቲው ስለተዘጋ በኢትዮጵያ አየር መንገድ የአውሮጵላን ጥገና ማሰልጠኛ ትምህርት ቤት(Aircraft Maintenance Technician schooll) በመግባት የሁለት ዓመት ስልጠና አጠናቆ በዲፕሎማ ተመረቀ።

በ1972 ዓ.ም. የአውሮፕላን ሞተር ጥገና ክፍል በመደልደል ሥራውን ጀመረ። ዩኒቨርሲቲውን እንዲለቅ ያደረገው የትግል እንቅስቃሴ ብልጭ እና ድርግም ሲል ቆይቶ በ1974 ዓ.ም. ስለፈነዳ ትግሉን መቀላቀል ግድ የሚለው ሆነ። በዚህ የትግል ወቅት የወጣት ማህበሩን (Youth League) እና የሠራተኛውን ማህበር በማቀናጀት ለተወሰነ ጊዜ እንደሠራ ሥልጣን በጨበጠው ወታደራዊ መንግስት ሥለተጋለጠ በከተማው ውስጥ የሚካሄደውን የሕቡዕ እንቅስቃሴ ለመቀጠል ተገደደ።

በከተማው ሕቡዕ እንቅስቃሴ ውስጥ እንዳለ ወታደራዊው መንግስት የሱን እና መሰሎቹን ፎቶግራፍ በከተማ ውስጥ በማሰራጨት አሰሳ በመጀመሩ ከተማውን ለቆ ወደ ትግራይ ክፍለ ሀገር በማቅናት በኢጋሜ አውራጃ ሠንገይ ተብሎ በሚጠራው ስፍራ የኢሕአፓን ሠራዊት ኢሕአሠን ተቀላቀለ።

በትግራይ ክፍለሀገር የኢጋሜን አውራጃ ጨምሮ በአድዋ፤ በክለተአውላሎ እና ጎንደር ክፍለሀገር በመዘዋወር በተለያዩ አውራጃዎች ሲታገል ቆይቷል።

መንግሥት መንጋጋ ፈልቅቆ ለማውጣት ከቦታ ቦታ እየተዘዋወረ ለሦስት ዓመት ሲታገል ቆይቶ ሁኔታው ላሰበው ዓላማ ፍጻሜ ላይ የማያደርሰው መሆኑን ስለተረዳ የሚወዳትን እናት ሀገሩን ኢትዮጵያን ለቆ ወደሱዳን መሰደድ ግድ ሆነበት።

ሙሉጌታ ሱዳን በነበረበት ጊዜ ከሁመራ እና ከተለያዩ የኢትዮጵያ ክፍለሀገር በጨቋኙ የደርግ መንግሥት በግድ ከየገባያው እየታፈሱ ወደጦር ግንባር ከተወሰዱ በኋላ አምልጠው ወደሱዳን የተሰደዱትን ወታደሮች በማሰባሰብ ሜዳ ከቀረው የኢሕአወ ሠራዊት ጋር በማገናኘት በጽናት ትግሉን ቀጠለ።

በ1979 ዓ.ም. በሚታገልበት በኢሕአፓ/ ኢሕአወ ድርጅት ውስጥ በተነሳው አለመግባባት ትግሉን ለመቀጠል አስቸጋሪ ሆኖ ስላገኘው፤ ሲታገል እና ሲያስትግል የነበረውን ድርጅት ለቆ ዳግማዊ ሰደቱን ሱዳን በገባ ከአንድ ዓመት ተኩል በኋላ በግንቦት ወር 1981 ዓ. ም. ወደ ሰሜን አሜሪካ ሲያትል ዋሺንግተን አቀና።

ሲአትል ዋሺንግተን (Seattle, Washinton) እንደገባ አንድም በሙያው በአየር መንገድ ተቀጥሮ መሥራት ወይም ያቋረጠውን ትምህርት መቀጠል በሚለው ሃሰብ ለብዙ ጊዜ ከራሱ ጋር ከታገለ በኋላ ሚዛኑ ወደደፋበት ትምህርት በ1982 ዓ.ም. ሲአትል ኮሚኒቲ ኮሌጅ (Seattle Community College) በመግባት ትምህርቱን ቀጠለ።

የሁለት ዓመቱን የኮሚኒቲ ኮሌጅ ትምህርቱን አጠናቅቆ በዋሺንግተን ዩኒቨርሲቲ (University Of Washintonon) በመግባት በኤሌትሪካል ኢንጂነሪንግ (Electrical Engineering) የመጀመሪያ ዲግሪውን በ1986 ዓ.ም. አጠናቀቀ። ዳግም ፑልማን (Pullman) በሚገኘው ዋሺንግተን እስቴት ዩኒቨርሲቲ (Washington State Univ-rsity) በመግባት ሁለተኛውን ዲግሪውን እየሠራ ሳለ Renton የሚገኘው Kenworth ተብሎ የሚጠራው የTrack ኩባንያ ለሥራ ስለጠራው ስራውን ተቅብሎ በInstrument design ለአንድ ዓመት ያህል ሲሠራ ቆየ።

በዚህ ሥራው ላይ እንዳለ በሙያው እና በተማሪበት ከዚህም ቀደም በኢትዮጵያ አየር መንገድ ይሠራበት ከነበረው የአውሮፕላን ጥገና ጋር የተያያዘ ሥራ በማግኘቱ Kenworthን ለቆ Everett, Washington በሚገኘው የቦይንግ ኩባንያ በ1991 ሕይወቱ እስካለፈበት ጊዜ ድረስ በኤሌትሪካል ዲዛይን(Electrical Design) በቦይንግ 767፣ 777 እና 787 ለሃያ ዓመታት ሲሠራ ቆይቷል።

በ1989 ዓ.ም. ውድ የትዳር ጓደኛ የሆነችውን ወይዘሮ ዘነበች አደራን በማግባት ከዚህ ዓለም በሞት እስከተለየችው ድረስ አራት ልጆች አፍርተው አብረው በፍቅር ኖሩ። ባለቤቱ ወይዘሮ ዘነበች አደራ በሞት ከተለየችው ዕለት ጀምሮ የናታቸውን ሞት እንዳያስቡ አራት ልጆቹን አራት ዓመት ሙሉ በትዕግስት እና በጥሩ እንክብካቤ

ብቻውን ያለ እናት ሲያሳድግ ቆይቶ በተውለደ በ 58 ዓመቱ ጥቅምት 23 ቀን 2011 ዓ.ም. በድንገት ከዚህ ዓለም በሞት ተለየን።

አቶ ሙሉጌታ በነበረው ልዩ ተወዳጅ ባሕሪዎች በሲያትልና አካባቢው በሚኖሩ ኢትዮጵያውያን እጅግ የተከበረና አንድ ሕብረተሰብ ዓምድ ለመታየት የበቃ ነው። ህመማንን በመጠየቅ፣ ያዘኑትን በማፅናናት፣ ይተገዱትን በማበረታታት ለብዙዎቻችን ችግር ፈጥኖ ደራሽ ስለነበረ ትዝታው የማይረሳ ነው። ያጋጠሙትን ፈተናዎች በሙሉ በተዕግሥትና በበጎ መንፈስ በመመልከት ሊወጣቸው ችሏል።

ሙሉጌታ ከአንደበቱ ክፉ ቃል የማይወጣው ኢትዮጵያዊ ጨዋነትን የተላበሰ በመሆኑ ትዕግሥቱ ለብዙዎቻችን አርአያ ሆኗል።

Out of their true love they were blessed with four wonderful children that now are survivors of both Mulugetta and Zenebech (their mom who died four years ago).

Mulgetta did his best to be an exceptional father that he was. He even tried to cover the missing part, as he tried to be both dad and mom. He dedicated himself to his children. He raised them alone for the last four years. He tried to look for good things in life even on his difficult days.

Mulugetta lived his life as a gentleman! He never raised his voice with rage. He was a true Ethiopian in how he treated all people with respect and kindness. We all are blessed to have known a man of such character.

Then, the stress of being a perfectionist in all things he ever did, and living without his soul mate, and raising teenagers by himself was too much to take. He was only human!

Mr. Mulugetta Gabre's Brief Life Story

Mr. Mulugetta Gabre was born in the city of Addis Ababa Ethiopia, on December 25th 1952 European Calendar, from his mother Mrs. Zelekech Sadura and his father Gabre Chaso.

Because his parents were merchants' they moved from Addis Ababa to Harer, Eastern Ethiopia and they took their first born child Mulugetta with them.

As Mulugetta became a school age boy, he was enrolled in missionary school where he attended all of his elementary schooling. Then, he was transferred to Lul Rass Mekonen Middle School. He then attended all of his high school years at Harer Medhanealem high school.

After completing his high school years with excellent GPA (Grade Point Average), he was enrolled in Addis Ababa University which used to be known as Kedamawi Haileselassie University.

But, his enrollment was short-lived as it was interrupted by constant riots that the University Students lead in 1970s; which at the end caused the University to totally shutdown.

At this stage, Mulugetta decided to take a different route. He was enrolled in Ethiopian Airlines Aircraft Maintenance Technical School. After two years of training, he graduated with Diploma.

In 1972 European Calendar, he started working for Ethiopian Airlines in the department of Airplane Engine Maintenance.

Meanwhile, the struggle and the riots by the University Students continued although on and off. In 1974, the revolution happened and Mulugetta felt strongly to be part of the revolution and he played a role in coordinating the Labor Associations and the youth League. But, soon he end up being one of the wanted men who were hunted by the new Military Junta.

The Military Junta posted his picture as one of the most wanted!

That is when Mulugetta left the city of Addis Ababa and headed north to the province Tigray to join the freedom fighters against the military Junta.

After three years of participation in the armed struggle against the regime, he was forced to flee to the Sudan and work on a new mission. While in Sudan, he was re-grouping his units also attracting deserters from the army to join the resistance force. His honesty, determination and high regard for his county men earned him a great trust among his compatriots. He was instrumental in convincing many soldiers to change sides during his stay in the Sudan.

In 1979, after continuously fighting for years to guarantee Ethiopian People the Freedom they deserve, a new conflict within his own party forced Mulugetta to change course and migrate to the United States in May of 1981.

As he settled in Seattle Washington, he thought about working as an Airplane Technician or goes back to school and earn a degree. After contemplating with those ideas for some time, he then decided to go back to school.

In 1982 he was enrolled in Seattle Community College and earned his Associate Degree. Mulugetta immediately transferred to University of Washington where he studied Electrical Engineering and received his Bachelor Degree in 1986.

As Mulugetta went back to school to get his second degree and was attending at Washington State University in Pullman, he was offered a Position with a company in Renton Washington named Kenworth Track Company. He accepted the offer and came back to work for them as Instrument Designer and worked for about a year.

In 1991 he took a new position with Boeing in Everett Washington. Since his new position includes using the knowledge he accumulated from going to Ethiopian Air-line Maintenance Technical School, and let him use his years of experience that he gained working for Ethiopian Airlines, plus apply what he had learned as Electrical Engineer, it felt right to be working for Boeing.

Mulugetta worked for Boeing as an Electrical Designer from 1991 to the day that he took his last breath. He had worked on Boeing 767,777and 787.

Mulugetta's personal discipline weren't only on his educational follow through, his political stand and commitment, his work ethics but he was true to his word dedicated loving husband and an amazing dad to his four children.

In 1989, he was married to his lovely wife Zenebech Adera and they had a life that can truly be defined as a real Christian Marriage! They lived with out fault no matter how big of an adversity they had to face in their
