- Imposed an officially non existent press censorship and banne some books outright though it denied the act;
- Set up satellite or state controlled newspapers posing as independent ones;
- Maintained its quasi absolute control over the media (TV and Radio included);

- Blocked internet access to independent web sites;
- Jammed totally and all over the country opposition radios like Finote
 Democracy radio
- etc.

Freedom of the oppress does not exist in Ethiopia and as we observe this May 3 World Press Freedom Day we are obliged to expose the hypocrisy of the repressive Meles regime and to call on the world to condemn with vigor this predator of the free press. Journalists in the various prisons and all political prisoners whould also be released.
